- 3 1/3 yds Dark red batik fabric for piecing
- 1/3 yd Purple batik fabric for piecing
- 2/3 yd Light purple batik fabric for piecing
- 1/3 yd Pink batik fabric for piecing
- 1/4 yd Red/pink patterned fabric with circles for piecing
- 1/4 yd Yellow patterned fabric for piecing
- 1/4 yd Pink/yellow fabric with squares for piecing
- 5/8 yd Black/white checked fabric for piecing
- 7/8 yd Black fabric for piecing
- 22 yds Fusible black bias tape, 1/4"
- 59" x 59" Batting
- Machine embroidery thread in black
- Matching sewing thread in yellow, dark red and light purple
- Safety pins
- Fabric marker
- Rotary cutter, cutting mat and a ruler
- 1/4-inch Quilting foot
- Free-motion Quilt foot
- Quilt needle

PFAFF®

1. Cutting:

1/4" seam allowance included

- Dark red batik
2 pieces – 14" x 18" piecing
2 pieces – 5" x 8 1/2" piecing
59" x 59" quilt back, join if necessary
- Purple batik
4 pieces – 3" x 14" piecing
4 pieces – 3 1/2" x 14" piecing
- Light purple batik
4 pieces – 3" x 14" piecing
4 pieces – 4 1/2" x 18" piecing
2 pieces – 3 1/2" x 8 1/2" piecing
- Pink batik
4 pieces – 5" x 8 1/2" piecing
4 pieces – 3 1/2" x 8 1/2" piecing
2 pieces – 4 1/2" x 16 1/2" piecing
- Red/pink patterned fabric with circles
2 pieces – 7 1/2" x 8 1/2" piecing
- Yellow patterned fabric
4 pieces – 7 1/2" x 8 1/2" piecing
- Pink/yellow patterned fabric with squares
4 pieces – 6" x 7 1/2" piecing
- Black/white checked fabric
4 pieces – 5 1/2" x 6 1/2" piecing
1 piece – 11" x 13" piecing
- Black
2 pieces – 2" x 16 1/2"
2 pieces – 2" x 14"
8 pieces – 1 1/2" x 8 1/2"
8 pieces – 1 1/2" x 7 1/2"
2 pieces – 3" x 50 1/2" borders
2 pieces – 3" x 54" borders
5 pieces – 2 1/2" x the width of the fabric
- Batting
59" x 59"

2. Sewing:

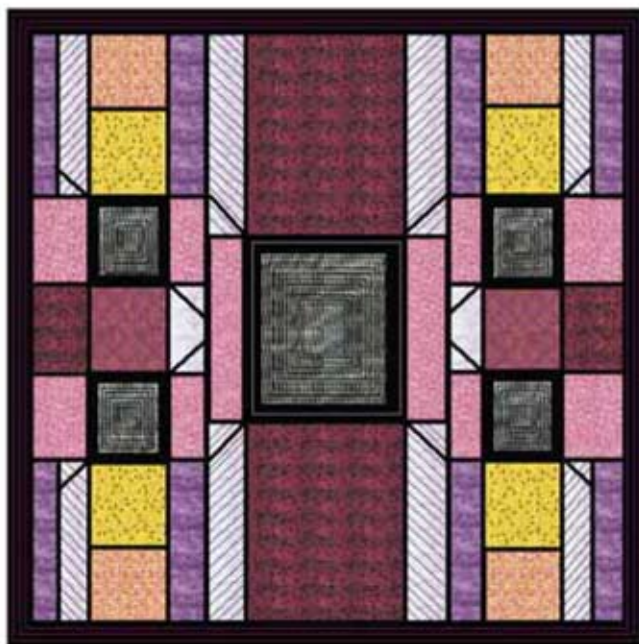
- Refer to the layout designs for the placement of the piecing squares and rectangles.
- Attach the 1/4" quilting foot to your ClassicStyle Quilt sewing machine. Thread your sewing machine with neutral cotton sewing thread on the top and in the bobbin. Stitch the squares and rectangles together in rows from left to right according to the layout design, using a straight stitch and a 1/4" seam allowance. Press the seam allowance to the dark colored fabric. Sew the rows together as per the layout design.
- Press the fusible bias tape over the ditches (seam lines). Start with the diagonals and then follow with the verticals and finish with the horizontal seams. Sew a straight stitch in the middle of the tape with black embroidery thread to secure the bias tape.
- Attach the borders. Place the 3" strips of black fabric, right sides together, with the pieced top and sew with 1/4" seams.
- Make a quilt sandwich by placing the quilt backing face down on the table, layer the batting on top and then the pieced quilt top right side up. Secure the layers with safety pins.

3. Quilting:

- Quilt the large light purple rectangles with diagonal rows of straight stitches. Use matching light purple sewing thread.
- Echo quilt rectangles in the black checked pieces using black sewing thread. Space the rows at 1/2" intervals.
- Attach the Free-motion quilt foot and set up your Pfaff ClassicStyle Quilt sewing machine for free-motion stitching. Stipple stitch on the dark red batik and yellow patterned pieces. Use matching dark red and yellow thread.
- Embellish the quilt with different quilt stitches. We used black embroidery thread and stitch numbers 31, 37, 38 and 40 from the Pfaff ClassicStyle Quilt. Sew the stitches beside the ditch using the edge of your presser foot as a guide.



- Stitch in the ditch on the seam between the quilt top and the black border.



4. Binding:

- Cut enough binding strips 2 1/4" x the width of your fabric to equal the total measurement of all four sides of your quilt.
- Join the strips together to get the length you need by laying the ends right sides together at a right angle; sew across the ends diagonally.
- Trim the seam allowance to reduce the bulk at seam and press open.
- Fold the binding strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- Pin the binding to the back of the quilt, matching raw edges.
- Stitch in place with a 1/4" seam, mitering the corners as you go.
- Fold the binding to the front of the quilt and stitch in place.
