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## Shopping List:



- HUSQVARNA VIKING® DESIGNER® SE Limited Edition
- 18" pillow form
- 5/8 yard tone on tone or plain color decorator fabric
- 5/8 yard of fabric for wrap
- 2 yard piping or trim for wrap edges
- Assorted Rayon Embroidery threads
- INSPIRA™ Cut-A-Way Stabilizer
- Single Welt Cord Foot #412 62 70-45
- 1/2" wide Steam-A-Seam 2
- Mega Hoop

## Sewing Directions:

1. Start by making the basic pillow. Cut out two 18" squares of plain decorator fabric. Place right sides together with the other square and sew three sides, using a 1/4" seam allowance. Press under the seam allowance on the open side. Insert the pillow form. Close the open side with a slip stitch or place a strip of Steam-A-Seam 2 and fuse closed.
2. Customize the design shown, either in your HUSQVARNA VIKING® 4D Embroidery Software or in Designer SE Interactive Designer Customizing. Use the Zoom  and Rotate  icons for easy placement. The design is composed of D100SE29, D100SE30 and D100SE31. Don't worry about connecting all the stems and leaves. They can be joined with a satin stitch later. Change colors to your desired pallet.



Cut the wrap fabric in half, across the fabric width to create two 11 1/4" x 45" strips. Set half of it aside for the wrap lining. Hoop wrap fabric and INSPIRA™ Cut-A-Way Stabilizer in the Mega Hoop. Touch Interactive Designer Embroidery Icon  and embroider the design.

3. Remove embroidery unit and select pre-programmed Satin Stitch F4 . Adjust the width of the satin stitch to match the stems. Fill in the stems,  to connect to the center flower.
4. To make the pillow wrap, cut the embroidered strip of fabric to 7 1/2" wide or wider, depending on the width your embroidery turned out, and 37" long. Your band should have approximately 2" of fabric on each side of the embroidery. Snap on the 1/4" Welt Foot. Stitch trim or piping along the two long edges.
5. Cut the lining piece down to the size of your outer wrap piece. Place the embroidered piped piece right sides together with the lining piece. Stitch on the two long edges. Turn right side out and press. Press 1/2" to the wrong side on one short open end. Pull the cord out 1" or so and cut off 1/2" of the cord. Repeat for all four cord ends. This leaves the end of the piping "empty" .
6. Fold the band right sides together matching the two short edges. Insert the un-pressed end into the pressed under end. Pin. Topstitch through all the layers. Press. Slide onto the pillow.
