Elegance Shawl



Shopping List:

- PFAFF® Sewing Machine
- PFAFF® Adjustable Seam Guide Foot
- PFAFF® “_” Right Guide Foot w/IDT
- Clear Monofilament Thread
- Black Bobbin Thread
- Quilter’s Ruler
- Chalk Marking Pen
- Fabric Glue Stick
- Fray Check
- 21 ½" W x 71 ½" L Rectangle of Organza
- 10 - 21 ½" pieces ¼" Satin Ribbon
- 1 ¼ Yard 4" Fringed Decorative Trim

Elegance Shawl - Sewing Instructions:

PFAFF®

Construction:

1. On one short end, measure and mark a line 5" up from the cut edge across the width of the organza. Fold on line with wrong sides together and press.
2. Prepare your PFAFF® sewing machine for sewing by threading with monofilament on top and black bobbin thread, engage the IDT and attach the PFAFF® Adjustable Seam Guide Foot.
3. Adjust the foot so that the guide is aligned with the second red marked line from the inside. Adjust the needle position all the way to the right.
4. Running the guide of the foot along the fold, sew the width of the organza creating a pleat.
5. Lay wrap on a flat surface, measure and mark 1" up from the sewn line, creating another pleat.
6. Fold organza on the line, press and sew as in step #3.
7. Repeat steps 4-6 until there are 5 pleats on one end of the wrap.
8. Repeat steps 1-7 on the other short end of the wrap.
9. Apply sewers glue to the wrong side of each 21 ½" piece of ribbon.
10. Apply one piece of ribbon to the underside of each pleat.
11. Starting from one edge and working to the other, measure and mark 4 vertical lines 5" apart across the pleats.
12. Sew on the marked lines, stitching the pleats down toward the cut edge of the fabric.
13. Mark 5 vertical lines (2 ½" apart) between each of the seams you just created.
14. Sew pleats up on each line toward the body of the wrap.
15. Trim any excess threads or ribbon pieces away from each long edge of the wrap.
16. Prepare your machine by threading with matching construction thread, attaching the PFAFF® ¼" Right Guide Foot w/IDT and move the needle back to center position.
17. Create a shirttail hem on each long edge by pressing the edge under ¼" twice.
18. With folded edge along the guide, stitch hem.
19. Repeat steps 17-18 on short edges of wrap.
20. Align fringed decorative trim on top of hemmed short edge of wrap. The bottom of the fringe header should be aligned with the bottom of the hem.
21. Select a narrow zigzag stitch and snap on the Standard 0/A foot.
22. Stitch trim to wrap, trim off excess and repeat on second side.
23. Apply Fray Check to the raw edges of the trim.
